SACRAMENTO, Calif. – The Faculty Association of California Community Colleges (FACCC) appreciates the Governor's continued prioritization of the California Community Colleges and his recognition of their role in supporting the state's economic health and workforce needs.

"FACCC is grateful to the Governor for prioritizing higher education and recognizing the value of our community colleges," said FACCC President Sarah Thompson. "The proposal includes important investments, but we must acknowledge that the current allocation model continues to disadvantage districts operating under hold harmless. Built-in inequities remain, and this is not prosperity for all if those districts do not receive a cost-of-living adjustment. As the budget process moves forward, we look forward to working with the Administration and legislative leaders to improve upon today's proposal."
